Start the week with a Monoprix run. It's the local catch-all, and stocking up on water and snacks will save you later.



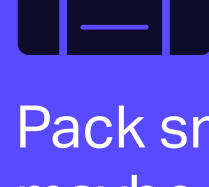
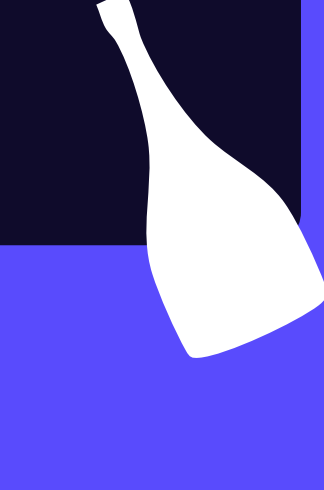
Eat when you can. There's no such thing as a quick meal here. Carry snacks and seize your food moments.

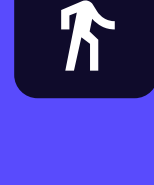

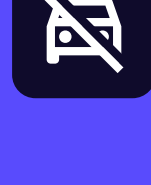

PRO TIP

By law French taxis have to accept card since 2016! If they are not, you are getting ripped off, and should get a different cab.

Evening Attire

Comfortable Shoes

Functional Bag

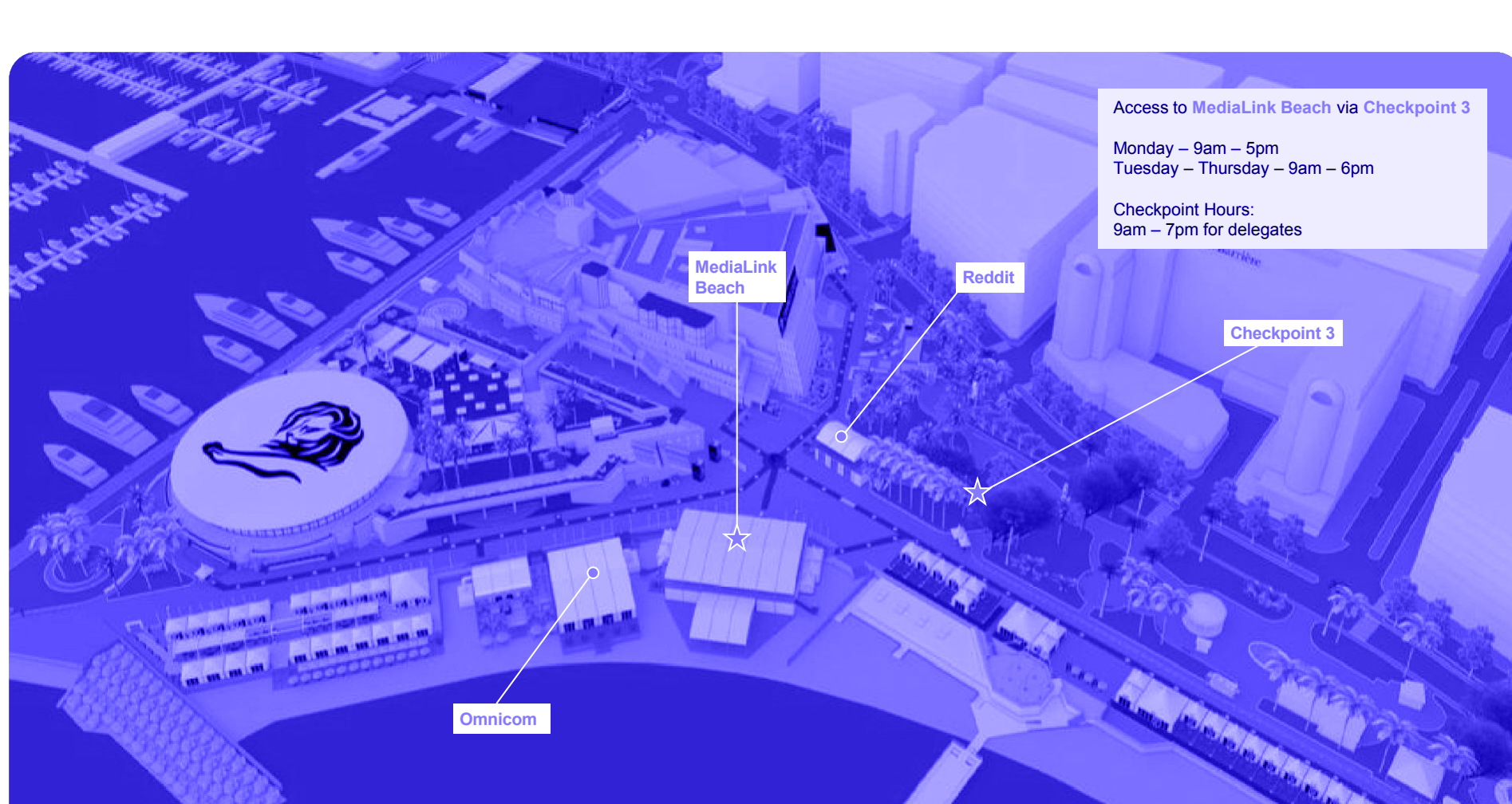
